Rusky versus Rossiisky

ROSSIISKY (РОССИЙСКИЙ)

- (def) related to the Russian state
- Российский флаг = Russian Flag
- Российский паспорт = Russian Passport
- Российское государство = Russian State

RUSSKY (РУССКИЙ)

- (def) related to Russian (Slavic) ethnicity
- Русский язык – Russian Language
- Русская культура – Russian Culture
- Русский народ – the Russian People



Святая Русь – lit. Holy Rus, also known as Ancient Rus, or Kyivskaya Rus (named so after Kyiv, the capitol)

- Orthodox Christianity established as the state religion by Knyaz Vladimir Svyatoslavovich through infamous mass baptisations and subsequent repressions of Slavic paganism. (~988-991AD)

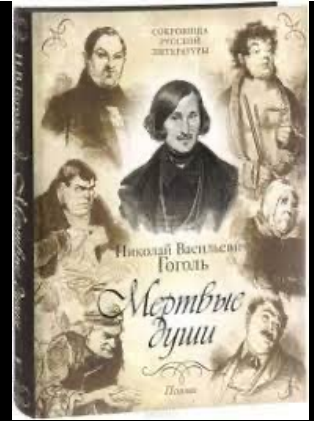
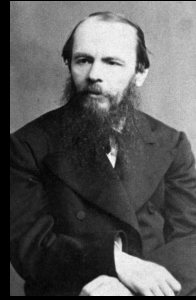
Holy Rus is ruled by the head of Russian State (Putin) with the spiritual support of the Moscow Orthodox Patriarchy.

Mystic Russian Soul – nationalist 19th century literary concept developed by Vissarion Bellinsky inspired by Nikolai Gogol's "Dead Souls"; a concept suggesting that Russians are unique and pure due to their heritage – qualities that are not shared by any other culture, ethnicity or nationality.

Similar: Russian Exceptionalism

Used by Dostoyevsky, Tolstoy and other Russian Writers of the 19th and 20th century, popularizing this myth overseas through their works.

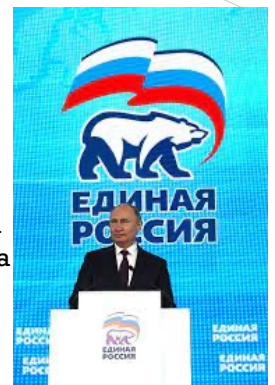


Establishment of Russky Mir as State ideology

Notable figures: Pyotr Shedrovitsky, Sergei Gradirovsky, Yefim Ostrovsky, Vladislav Surkov, Alexandr Dugin, and others



- Vladislav Surkov – ex-presidential advisor, political scientist, author of the Единая Россия (United Russia Party) single-party control system.
- Rusky Mir:
 - where people speak and think in Russian,
 - where they say that they respect Russian culture,
 - where our scientists, our writers, our art are respected,
 - where Putin is respected,
- and where Russian weapons are feared

What are CCC's?

- **Coordinated Councils of Compatriots** - councils formed from heads of organisations and initiatives within Russian communities abroad, which are self-described to promote and support Russian language and culture within their broader communities
- **Compatriots** – Russian nationals and their descendants living outside the territory of the Russian Federation and relating, as a rule, to peoples historically residing on the territory of the Russian Federation, as well as those who have made a free choice in favor of spiritual, cultural and legal ties with the Russian Federation
- Only the head or director of the organization or initiative may apply for membership

"In my view, we need to support the initiative put forward by Russian linguists to create a National Russian Language Foundation, the main aim of which will be to develop the Russian language at home, support Russian language study programmes abroad and generally promote Russian language and literature around the world."

- Headed by **Vyacheslav Nikonov**, Dean of History and Political Science at the International University in Moscow and founder of the Polity Foundation.
- Established in 2007 by decree of Vladimir Putin
- Funded from public and private sources, including the State Budget





World Congress of Russian Compatriots

- World Coordinating Council of Compatriots established the the II World Congress of Compatriots (St. Petersburg, 2006)
- I World Congress of Compatriots (2001) – representatives from 47 foreign countries
- VI World Congress of Compatriots (2018) – representatives from 98 countries
- VII World Congress of Compatriots (2021) – representatives from 102 countries
- Chairman – Sergei Lavrov (Minister of Foreign Affairs), participants greeted by Vladimir Putin, Margarita Simonyan, Patriarch Kirill of all Russia, Valentina Matvienko and others

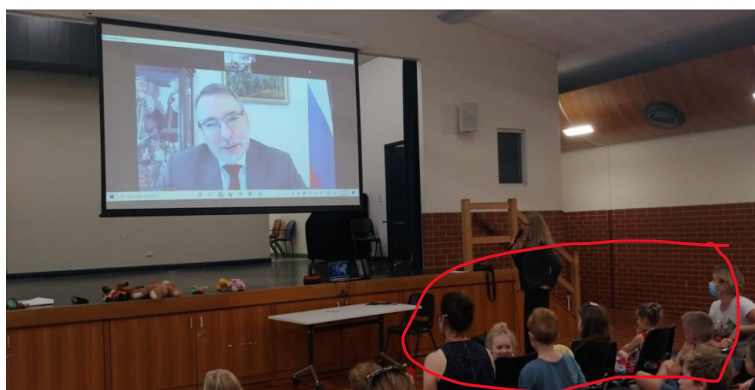

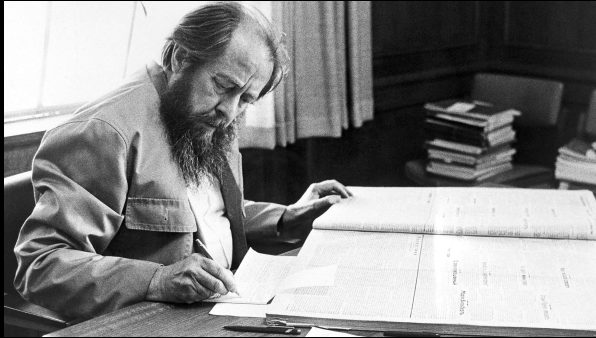
